Lexicographical combinatorial generation and Gray codes for noncrossing and nonnesting set partitions of classical type

Resumo: A Gray code is a listing structure for a set of combinatorial objects such that some consistent (usually minimal) change property is maintained throughout adjacent elements in the list. I shall present combinatorial Gray codes and explicit designs of efficient algorithms for lexicographical combinatorial generation of the sets of noncrossing and nonnesting set partitions of length n for all classical types.
